- How can I use different colours or materials for effect?



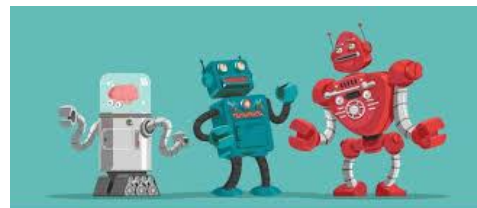
Key Skills...

Recycled	When an object or material is put through a process that allows it to be reused.
Sculpture	The art of making 2D or 3D Art.
Tone	The brightness or shade of a colour.
Shape	The appearance of an object as defined by its outline.
Metallic	Made of or to look like metal.
