### Grammar

In Spanish, most planet names are **masculine**, except for “the Earth” **La Tierra**, which is **feminine**.

**El Sol** (the Sun) is masculine, and **la Luna** (the Moon) is feminine.

### Masculine/feminine adjectives:

**frío/fría**- cold

**pequeño/pequeña**- small

**grande**- big

**caliente**– hot

**azul**- blue

**blanco/blanca**– white

**naranja** - orange

**rojo/roja** - red

**La Luna es pequeña** - The moon is small.

**El Sol es grande** – The Sun is big.

**La Tierra es azul** – The Earth is blue.

**Venus es azul** – Venus is blue
